



## Roseboro Town Grounds Rental Agreement

Roseboro town grounds (park or monument area) may be rented to responsible persons age 18 and over, for events such as family gatherings, parties, fundraisers, and recreational activities. The following rental agreement and fees are applicable. A rental fee of \$35.00 will apply to water/sewer customer/tax payers within town limits. A rental fee of \$60.00 will apply to persons residing outside town limits.

1. Hours of operation sun-up to sun-down.
2. No littering on the grounds. Grounds must be picked up before departure or a fee will apply. (Example: decorations, balloon parts/streamers, paper, cups, utensils, cigarette butts, etc.)
3. Garbage is to be placed in cans provided and can lids closed at time of departure.
4. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on premises.
5. No loud music shall be played according to Town Ordinance Sec. 22-5. - Noises (see attached).
6. No cars should park in a way that will block the driveways of the surrounding dwellings or businesses.
7. No renter can sublease any space, in whole or in part, within the town for any reason.
8. Will you have any rental equipment like bouncy houses or inflatables of any kind? ☐ YES ☐ NO  
All party rental equipment vendors must possess a Certificate of Insurance with the Town of Roseboro listed as an additional insured. Will you need electricity? ☐ YES ☐ NO
9. Any renter must provide a copy of 1) homeowner's insurance or 2) Certificate of Insurance with the Town of Roseboro listed as an additional insured. Additional insurance information is attached.
10. Anyone wishing to access town grounds during your event is allowed by law because this is public property.

**Please be aware that extra fees may be charged if rules above are not followed.**

Sec. 22-5. - Noises.

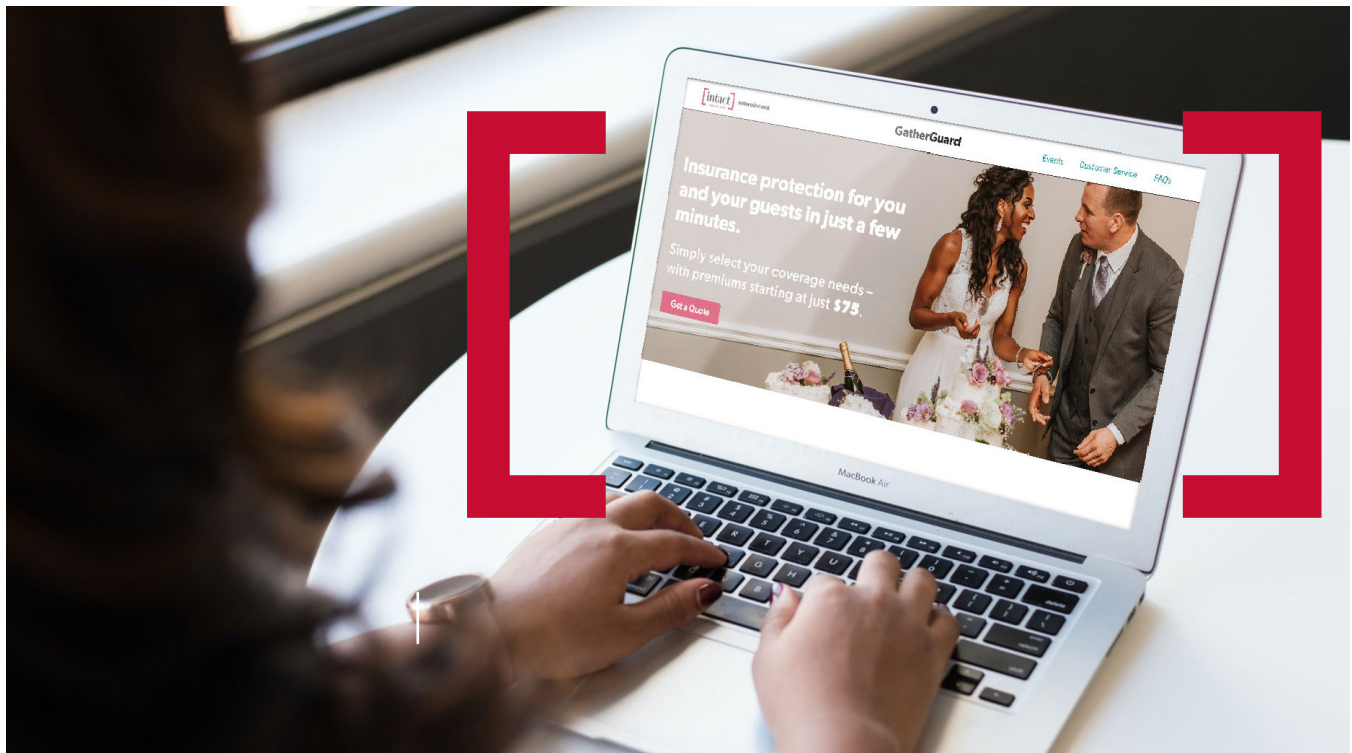
- (a) *General prohibition.* Subject to the provisions of this section, the creation of any unreasonably loud, disturbing and unnecessary noise is prohibited, as is also noise of such character, intensity and duration as to be detrimental to the life or health of others.
- (b) *Specific sounds, conditions expressly prohibited.* The following acts, among others, are declared to be loud, disturbing and unnecessary noises in violation of this section; this enumeration shall not be deemed to be exclusive:
  - (1) *Blowing horns.* The sounding of any horn or signal device on any automobile, motorcycle, bus or other vehicle while at a standstill, except when sounded as a danger signal, or if such vehicle should be in motion, when used as a danger signal as brakes are being applied; the creation, by means of any signal device, of unreasonably loud or harsh sounds; and the sounding of such device for an unnecessary and unreasonable period of time.
  - (2) *Gongs or sirens on vehicles.* The use of any gong or siren upon any vehicle other than a police, fire or other emergency vehicle.
  - (3) *Radios, phonographs, etc.* The playing of any radio, phonograph, or other musical instrument in such a manner or with such a volume, particularly during the hours between 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., as to disturb the quiet, comfort or repose of a reasonable person.
  - (4) *Pets.* The keeping of any animal or bird which, by emitting frequent or long continued noise, disturbs the comfort and repose of any reasonable person.
  - (5) *Use of vehicles.* The use of any automobile, motorcycle or other vehicle which is so out of repair or loaded in such a manner as to create loud or unnecessary grating, grinding, rattling or other noises.
  - (6) *Steam whistles.* The blowing of any steam whistle attached to any stationary boiler, except when to give notice to begin or stop work, or as a warning of danger.
  - (7) *Exhaust discharge.* The discharge into the open air of the exhaust of any steam engine, stationary internal combustion engine, motor vehicle or motor boat engine, except through a muffler or other device which will effectively muffle otherwise loud or explosive exhaust noises.
  - (8) *Devices using compressed air.* The use of any mechanical device operated by compressed air, unless the noise created thereby is effectively muffled.
  - (9) *Building operations.* The erection (including excavating), demolition, alteration or repair of any building in a residential or business district, other than between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. on weekdays, except in the case of urgent necessity in the interest of public safety and then only with a special permit from the building inspector, which permit may be renewed for a period of three days or less while the emergency continues.
  - (10) *Noises near schools, hospitals, churches, etc.* The creation of excessive noise on any street

adjacent to any school, institution of learning or court, while same is in session, or within 150 feet of any hospital, where such noise might unreasonable interfere with the working of such institution; provided, however, that conspicuous signs are displayed in such streets indicating that the same are either school, court or hospital streets, or on Sundays on any street adjacent to any church, provided that conspicuous signs are displayed in streets adjacent to churches indicating that the same are church streets.

- (11) *Loading and unloading operations.* The creation of loud and excessive noise in connection with the loading or unloading of any vehicle, or with the opening and destruction of bales, boxes, crates and containers.
- (12) *Bells or gongs attached to buildings.* The sounding of any bell or gong attached to any building or premises, which disturbs the quiet or repose of persons in the vicinity, with the exception of churches.
- (13) *Hawking, peddling or soliciting.* The shouting and crying of peddlers, barkers, hawkers and vendors which disturbs the quiet and peace of reasonable persons.
- (14) *Noises to attract attention.* The use of any drum, loud speaker or other instrument or device for the purpose of attracting attention to a performance, show, sale or display of merchandise.
- (15) *Garage noises at night in residential districts.* The conducting, operating or maintaining of any garage or filling station in a residential district in such a manner that loud or offensive noises are emitted therefrom between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.
