Roseboro is conveniently located less than two hours from the crystal coasts, and four hours from the beautiful North Carolina mountains. Fayetteville is only 25 miles west and Raleigh, the state's capital, is 60 miles north. Clinton, which is the county seat is around 12 miles east and Wilmington is about 60 miles southeast.

Climate

Our climate is warm in the summer with temperatures ranging from the 70s to the 90s. July is the warmest month with an average maximum temperature around 90 degrees Fahrenheit. In the winter the temperature is usually in the 40s. January is the coldest month with an average minimum temperature of about 32 degrees Fahrenheit. Our average annual rainfall is about 49 inches.
